In light of the frustrating situation those in the local areas of Yelvertoft, Onley, Norton and Spratton currently find themselves in in relation to the local bus services, Chris would like to organise a meeting between yourselves and Mr Tony Ciaburro, Project Director of Transport Transformation at the University of Northampton.

Mr Ciaburro has a very exciting proposal which is beginning to get its feet off the ground. It is called the Demand Responsive Transport Proposal and he wishes to extend this bus scheme nationally. However, provisionally a pilot study is being looked into which could offer a service to local people. Mr Ciaburro is keen to get a pilot study up and running.
