20.01.001	<p>Daventry SUE Presentation</p> <p>Pegasus presented their proposed master plan for 3,400 homes, saying that the only change since the May 2018 was the removal of the canal arm which is no longer going ahead.</p> <p>Planning applications will be submitted to Daventry District Council by the end of January 2020. They are hoping to start building in a couple of years and will need to update some of the surveys and traffic counts again. It is anticipated that completion of the project will take 15-20 years.</p> <p>Provision for a secondary and two primary schools are included in the plans.</p> <p>Council has requested the following for the website to keep residents updated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A brief monthly update once plans have been submitted and validated; • A digital copy of the master plan.
