20.07.104	Public Open Forum – Nothing to report.
20.07.105	The following apologies for absence were received and approved: Carol Childs, Jeff Paybody and Julia Richardson. Cllr Chris Thomas was absent.
20.07.106	There were no Declarations of Interest for items on the agenda.
20.07.107	RESOLVED to approve the minutes of the virtual annual meeting of the Parish Council held on Monday 16 June 2020. <u>Update on actions from the above meeting:</u> 20.06.097 - The Clerk advised that, apart from the current tenant, nobody had, to date, responded to the advertisements on the website and noticeboard regarding the sale of The Pound. If no further expressions of interest are received by the closing date, the clerk will write to the tenant offering The Pound to him. Action: Clerk 20.06.100 – The Chair reported that the approximate cost of a brass plaque to commemorate those that have lost their lives due to the Coronavirus, would be approximately £50. It was agreed to have an unveiling ceremony to which family members of the deceased would be invited. Action: Chair
